Dear Calvary Family,

Many times, when I sit down to write this article, I have a hard time deciding what to say. Not so, this time. We are deep into the discernment phase of considering joining with Colonial Avenue Baptist Church in dissolving our respective churches and beginning a new congregation. It seems like it's been a long time since we started prayerfully pondering what God would have us do, but I am certain it is impossible to "over-pray" anything ... especially something as important as starting a new Church. Williams of Colonial Presbyterian, and I will be working together on a Summer Sermon Series. It's a thirteen-part series called Holy Habits. The messages are about spiritual disciplines that help one feel closer to God and more sensitive to God. Most of the time when we think about spiritual disciplines, we only think of the study of scripture and prayer. While these holy habits are the cornerstones of a faith centered life, there are many other ways we can build a stronger relationship with God. I don't know about you, but I can always use more pathways to get closer to God.

The series will begin on June 4 with an introduction and conclude at the end of August.

Here's the exciting part: Rev. Scott, Rev. Williams and I are going to be rotating pulpits for the summer. While I'll be at Calvary most of the time, on occasion I'll be preaching at one of the other two churches.

There are exiting days ahead at Calvary. I'm looking forward to sharing them with you.


Have you ever had the feeling that something was so very, very right, but then when you did it, it ended up being so very, very wrong? Feelings lie. They lie to you all the time! There's an old country song that says, "How can it be wrong when it feels so right?" Are you kidding me? There are a lot of things that are wrong that feel so right in the moment.

After six months in a relationship, you wonder, "What was I thinking?" Just a few weeks into a job, you think, "How in the world did I get caught up in this?" A quick decision that seemed harmless at the time leaves you broken and scarred years later.

If you want to experience fewer dead ends and failures in your life, you need to hear what Proverbs 3:5-7 says: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the Lord and turn away from evil" (NLT).

If you really want God's blessing on your life, you have to depend on God's wisdom and not on what your feelings say or what your gut says. In other words, trust in the Lord and not on your own understanding.

So how do you get God's wisdom? You pray. You talk to God, and you let him talk to you as you read the Bible. That's how you get his wisdom.
